Are mattress audits, barrier programs, and surface integrity checks performed at least annually?	
Does the team conduct proactive rounding and inspections beyond scheduled PMs?

Are Quarterly Reviews or program meetings held to align goals and share data?

Are AEM plans, replacement strategies, and decommissioning reviewed annually?	
Does the team operate with a collaborative mindset — regardless of whether staff are internal or external?
